Companies must recognise that the invasion of Ukraine has changed the geopolitical framework irrevocably, posing major new threats to business – no matter how far away. The most immediate manifestation of this change is in the sanctions imposed on Russian entities – but businesses must assume that new, and unpredictable, threats will emerge, as the de facto “economic war” between major states takes shape.

This presentation will outline the risks of key concern to foreign business and to business leaders. Steve will address political risk issues, sanctions and wider business risks.
